The Faculty of Psychology and Education is housed in the Transitorium building, situated at the corner of *De Boelelaan* and the *Van der Boechorststraat*, in between the VU University main building and VUmc Hospital building.

Public transport

The VU University is in walking distance from Station Amsterdam Zuid/WTC (10 minute walk). However, if you want to use public transportation, tram 51 (direction ‘Amstelveen Westwijk’) or tram 5 (direction ‘Amstelveen Binnenhof’) are recommended (1 minute from Station Zuid/WTC to VU University).

From Central Station (not recommended)

Express tram 51 (16 minutes)
Tram 5 (25 minutes)
Tram 16 (35 minutes)


Car

The A-10 Amsterdam ring road can be reached from all directions. Follow the A-10 to the Zuid/Amstelveen exit S108. Turn left at the end of the slip road onto Amstelveenseweg: after about three hundred yards (at the VU Hospital building) turn left again onto De Boelelaan. The VU can be reached via city routes S108 and S109.

Parking

There is a limited amount of parking space around the VU itself in De Boelelaan, which has parking bays, and also in Karel Lotsyiaan. There is paid parking on the VU parking lot to the right of the Hospital Outpatient Clinic. There is even more parking space on the east side of Buitenveldertselaan at the junction with Willem van Weldammelaan, within 5 minutes walking distance of the VU. A number of parking places for the handicapped are reserved in front of the VU Main Building and within its grounds. The entrance is situated on the van der Boechorststraat.

In the map below, the Transitorium building is indicated with number '11'.
